The main purpose of the interims is to provide students, teachers, and parents or guardians with immediate in-depth data and a reliable estimate of students' current performance on selected subsets of content standards. The end-of-grade (EOG) and end-of-course (EOC) tests share a common question bank with NC Check-Ins 2.0, which then exposes students to similar question types and rigor found on the EOGs and EOCs.</p> <p>mCLASS is a universal screener that measures the development of reading skills of all students used in grades K-3.</p>
