

# Enrichment Committee

## Meeting Minutes

04/27/17

The Piedmont Community Charter School, Enrichment Committee met on Thursday April 27, 2017 with the following in attendance: Brad Putnam, Betty Cauble, Charlene Crawford, Melissa Williams, Paula Swift, Ernie Bridges, Alex Poole, Michael Satterfield and Mark Franklin.

The meeting was called to order and Mark Franklin shared the minutes from the March meeting. Charlene Crawford moved to approve the minutes and Ernie Bridges seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

Discussion began on using a survey tool from Advance Education to survey faculty/staff/students and parents. This survey is incorporated into the documentation used for the accreditation visit from Advance Education. The survey would be administered in the fall of 2017 and the faculty/staff and student surveys could be completed on site while the parent surveys would be obtained through email. The results would compare PCCS to other schools in the Advance Education network. The committee decided to administer the Advance Education survey in October of 2017 and then target Spring of 2019 for a follow-up survey. The NC Teachers Working Conditions survey will be given in Spring 2018.

The discussion then changed to how to understand MAP Test scores and how to track and chart this data. We discussed opportunities to compare MAP data with other schools in our area, state and region. We also discussed a vehicle to be able to better communicate the MAP data to the Board and parents.

The committee also discussed how the lack of an adequate science lab was negatively impacting science scores. It was recommended that the project to build a modern science lab be a priority for the board to fund. Michael Satterfield will contact an architect to start preliminary work on a science lab project.

The date for the next Enrichment Committee Meeting has been scheduled for Thursday May 25, 6:30 pm at the secondary campus. Kristen Rodriguez with TeamCFA will be invited to attend this meeting to review the Spring 2017 MAP scores with the committee.
