

Enrichment Committee

Meeting Minutes

The Piedmont Community Charter School, Enrichment Committee met on Thursday November 10, 2016 with the following in attendance: Brad Putnam, Betty Cauble, Paula Swift, Charlene Crawford, Jeff Waldrep, Melissa Williams, Jennifer Purdee, Jennifer Wyatt and Mark Franklin. This is the inaugural meeting of the Enrichment Committee.

The meeting was called to order and Mark Franklin shared information on the purpose and scope of the Enrichment Committee's function as it relates to three main areas of focus:

- Academics
- Faculty/Staff Satisfaction
- Parent/Student Satisfaction

The committee members were given a chart from each of the three areas of focus that was developed during the Piedmont Community Charter School Board work sessions in September and October of this year. The charts outline areas of interest under each of the three main areas of focus and then lists the current status, short term goals and long term goals for each area of interest. The Enrichment Committee has been tasked with determining metrics to measure progress in achieving the goals and a timeline for achieving the objectives.

The committee reviewed the information on academics and started the review of the information on faculty/staff satisfaction. It was agreed that MAP test results, EOG results and ACT results will be used as a measure of the progress in academics. An action item for the next meeting is to investigate how to conduct a faculty survey in a manner that promotes open and honest feedback.

The scheduled meeting time expired and the committee agreed to continue the review of the faculty/staff satisfaction and parent/student satisfaction charts at the next meeting.
