Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order and Mark Franklin shared the minutes from the December meeting. Charlene Crawford moved to approve the minutes and Melissa Williams seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

The committee continued the discussion of our three primary areas of focus:

- Academics
- Faculty/Staff Satisfaction
- Parent/Student Satisfaction

The discussion of Parent/Student satisfaction was initiated with the first topic being communication. PCCS uses multiple means of communication and these communication tools were discussed along with ways to measure their effectiveness. One communication tool that has been effective and could be utilized by more of the faculty is Remind 101. The enrichment Committee will explore opportunities to promote this tool with the entire faculty.

One of the areas of concern is communicating the goals and direction of PCCS so that they are fully understood by the PCCS community. The goal is to promote an environment of transparency and openness. It was suggested that along with the board minutes that a highlight summary of the board meetings be posted on the website. Also an effort needs to be made to promote parent involvement in the board meetings. A suggestion was made to schedule a Parent Forum to discuss the board governance process. Another suggestion was to schedule a Parent Forum to review the new PCCS strategic plan once it is completed.
