 Tests/Projects–50%

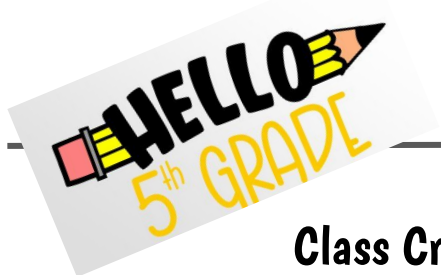
